RESOURCES IN NEW HAMPSHIRE

Hospitals: Many hospitals are required to offer free or reduced-fee medical services. Call your local hospital and ask to speak with the business office, finance department, financial counselor, or the social services department.

Community Health Centers: Federally qualified community health centers provide health care regardless of ability to pay. The New Hampshire Breast Cancer Resource Guide lists many New Hampshire community health centers. For a free copy of the guide, call (603) 659-3482.
